
# **Employment Sites Program (ESP)** for Public Infrastructure



# PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Pinellas County voters approved the Penny IV Referendum in 2017. 4.15% of its funds are dedicated to the Employment Sites Program (ESP).
- Dedicated funding for the ESP program
  is available for public infrastructure projects
  that promote targeted industry growth.
- Municipalities in Pinellas County are invited to submit applications for funding for infrastructure projects that promote business growth in the County.
